These included stints with the Council for Private Education, Ministry of Home Affairs, Tanjong Pagar Community Development Council, Ministry of Defence, the former Ministry of Information, Communications and the Arts, Public Service Division and Legal Service Commission Secretariat.

Mr Ho holds a Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering (First Class Honours) from the National University of Singapore. He currently sits on the Board of the Singapore Land Authority.
