MGOV@SG

mGov@SG (<u>www.mgov.gov.sg</u>) is a one-stop Government mobile site that aggregates different types of Government mobile services (m-services). Launched on 20 June 2011, it brings together more than 40 m-services, including mobile browser-based, native application-based and SMS-based services.

Optimised For Mobile Browsing

mGov@SG has a device-aware capability to filter and surface m-services that are relevant to the mobile device, and optimise the site's on-screen display. Featured listings on mGov@SG also allow users to zoom in quickly on popular m-services and recent additions to the site that are compatible with their mobile devices.

Ease of Finding M-Services

mGov@SG offers several ways for users to find the m-services of their choice.

- 1. **Categories**: Users with specific intents can locate the m-services through one of the nine categories of "Business", "Community & Housing", "Travel & Leisure", "Defence & Security", "Education & Learning", "General", "Health", "Jobs & Money" and "Transport".
- 2. **Organisations**: Users who wish to transact with a specific government agency, can first look up the agency under "Organisations" to browse through the agency's m-service offerings.
- 3. **Quick Search**: Users can perform a search for a specific government m-service with the search tool provided.
- 4. **Discover All**: Users can also choose to view, at one glance, all the government m-service offerings that are relevant to their mobile devices.
