ANNEX F-3: ONE-TIME MEDISAVE BONUS

As part of the Government's efforts to help Singaporeans offset healthcare costs and build up their medical savings for old age, we will provide a one-time MediSave Bonus to all adult Singaporeans between the ages 21 and 50 (born in 1974 – 2003). (Singaporeans born in 1973 or earlier will benefit from the MediSave Bonus component of the Majulah Package – see Annex F-2.)

The bonus will be tiered by their year of birth, the Annual Value ("AV") of their residence, and whether they own more than one property as at 31 December 2023 (see <u>Table 1</u> below), and will be credited to their CPF MediSave Account in December 2024.

About 1.4 million Singaporeans will receive the bonus, which is estimated to cost \$0.3 billion in total. Together with the MediSave Bonus under the Majulah Package for older Singaporeans, we will collectively provide support for the healthcare costs of about 3 million Singaporeans.
